"I AM" Educational Center (aka) Eagles Academy Nursery/Primary School

Giving education to the people here is one of our top priorities; this is because we knew that the cost of ignorance is most devastating. Okpoko, a rural Onitsha community is noted for mass illiteracy levels. When I entered this place the Lord told me to give them spiritual and academic

knowledge and educate their children. I don't know how to begin since I lack the finances to carry out the command. For twenty years I trusted God to do it exactly as He commanded.

Like the journey of many miles, I started in a second, in other words, in a small way. And some years back the Lord brought to me Roy L. Wanta, the international President of *"I AM" World Mission Outreach USA,* and through him, many of you started donating to



the vision of giving the children education.

Today there are many of them outside who will want to come to the school with your help. We appeal again for your support to give, so we can give as many as we can the basic nursery and primary education. It cost \$60 USD per pupil per term or a total of \$180 USD

for one school year. It is also our desire to be paying our teaching staff their salary and when due.

This we have not been doing because of poor finance. We have eleven teachers now. We pay them a total of \$1,120 USD monthly. The highest paid teacher receives \$150 USD per month and the least paid teacher receives \$80 USD per month. We also appeal for help in this regard.

Widows

"I AM" Nigeria is currently helping one hundred and twenty seven (127) widows, with food, house rent, medical supplies, hospital bills and clothing, etc.

In December 2011, our international

President Roy L. Wanta and other team members from USA could not believe what they saw as these widows were shedding tears of joy when food and other items were distributed to them.



We are developing a business and skills acquisition center to help some younger ones among them to have a means of livelihood. To end this, we need urgent support to start and agro-allied project and farm. The project will require \$5,000 USD. Meanwhile, two of these widows who are also childless are having health challenges. They need to be taken to the hospital for treatment. \$1,000 USD will go a long way in saving the life of these childless widows.

Their condition is critical. We appeal for urgent help.
