Ajara has received several beatings from her husband and other Muslims in the community until she recently divorced him and was thrown out of her matrimonial home, along with her sick son and her granddaughter. Her son Ibrahim, 37 years old, was knocked down by a vehicle and the driver just left without checking on him. After several interventions by doctors, his leg continued to twist. This situation led
