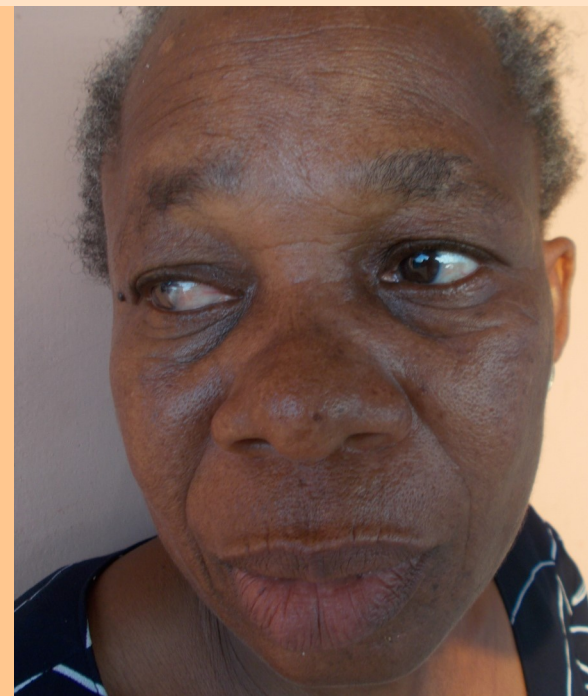
## Report by Roy Wanta

His wife left him to marry another man and Juliet, his twin sister and her husband, were the ones helping Jerome and his three children, who have been abandoned by their mother. Unfortunately Juliet's husband died leaving only Juliet to take care of her own daughter, her abandoned brother and his three children. Juliet sells food stuff to take care of



them, but now she is losing customers because where she would see the food, they have turned the place into a living room. Two years after the death of her husband they couldn't pay for the rent, so they had to move into the place where she sells her things. Her customers are not pleased with the selling condition and therefore they have stopped buying from her. *I am pleading to "I AM" WORLD MISSION to please come to their aid so that Juliet can continue to sell her items and be self sufficient. Getting a place for them to live would be very rewarding and make them all very happy. Thank You*

**Rebecca Zisou** is 47 years old and she works at the "I AM" DAY SCHOOL as caretaker of the kindergarten children. She has four children of her own and her husband is blind and needs her to take care of him. She is paid eight hundred Ghana cedi's (GH800.00) every month or approximately \$140 USD, for her work so she can take care of her family. Recently she detected some unusual pain in her eyes and could not see properly. She went and saw a doctor and he has diagnosed her of the same problem that happened to her husband. The doctors told her to prepare for operation as quickly as possible before that white tissue cover up the eye lens completely. *Pastor Benjamin is pleading on behalf of Rebecca, and her family to "I AM" WORLD MISSION to come to their aid for the operation. If Rebecca, who is the bread winner becomes blind, it will be a major disaster to the whole family. I hope their request will be granted, thank you!*

**Afia Owusua** is 46 years old with four children to take of. After her husband's death the family members told her to vacate the room, but she pleaded with them to let her stay so that she can take good care of the children. They agreed but relocated them into a very small room which is closer to the toilet room. She did not complain but kept on working hard. When her husband's family members saw that her business was growing, they became envious of her. They tried to poison her, and just four days ago somebody secretly poured kerosene onto the food that she sends to the market to sell, destroying everything. It is a clear sign that she is not welcome in the house. Now the problem is if she uses all the money she has to rent a room it means she will be out of business, and if she continues to stay there she will putting her life and that of the children at risk. *If it be in anyone's heart to help this widow get out of the situation she is in, she would be very thankful.*



**Doris Opoku** is fifty three years old with three children. She had two children with her late husband and after the death of her husband, as their custom demands she was forced to marry her late husband's brother. She accepted it in order not to leave her children to them. Later she had her third child with her brother-in-law. He now has thrown them out of their home accusing Doris of being a witch who has destroyed all his fortune because he started losing everything after taking Doris as her wife. Doris is now staying with a neighbor which is just temporary. *Doris is also looking for a place to live just like Afia and Juliet.*
