Comfort refused the orders and she therefore knew the consequence and had to escape with all her four children from the northern part of Ghana to the southern, specifically Ejisu. She has been given a temporal shelter on someone's farms but the place is too small and since this is just temporary, Pastor Benjamin is requesting help to get them a room so that people will not take advantage of their condition and jeopardize the life of her three girls. They would be very happy if their pleadings are considered. **Thank you.**
