So she started by fetching water and carrying it on her head to supply it to people's homes for money. She has now developed a severe pain and therefore can not work as she use to. The children and she are now living on the mercies of benevolent. Pastor Benjamin's son, Jenkins has sickle cell. With sickle cell disease, red blood cells contort into a sickle shape. The cells die early, leaving a shortage of healthy red blood cells (sickle cell anemia), and it can block blood flow causing pain. Jenkins is in a very critical condition at the hospital.
